Invitation For Bid GSA-038-25 DUI Extended Cargo Van

Questions and Concerns received from Cars Plus LLC on May 19, 2025.

1. Drive Train: All Wheel Drive with Traction control

Would this bid be willing to accept a Front Wheel Drive vehicle?

Please amend to read: Drive Train: All Wheel Drive/Front Wheel Drive acceptable

Explanation: FWD provides excellent traction, especially in varied conditions and when fully loaded, because the weight of the engine and transmission is over the front wheels.

Response: Please see Amendment #2.

Questions and Concerns received from Triple J Enterprises, Inc. on June 16, 2025.

- 2. Load Height: Load Height is only the distance from the ground to the van floor, 76 inches is 6.3 ft high so you would need a ladder to enter the van. Recommendation: Change Load Height to a maximum of 29 inches.

 Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.
- Interior Standing Height: Interior Height is an important measurement since this van will accommodate police
 officers and citizens of all heights, however no measurement is provided in the bid specifications.
 Recommendation: State minimum inside roof height of 76 inches (after DUI conversion) to allow occupant
 standing.

Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.

- 4. Transmission: Auxiliary transmission fluid coolers are not necessary for vehicles with today's transmission technology. Recommendation: Change to factory recommended heavy duty transmission.

 Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.
- Drive Train: All-Wheel Drive is unnecessary for a DUI Van, additionally AWD cargo vans are not available from some van manufacturers. Traction Control is already standard feature on today's vehicles.
 Recommendation: Amend to AWD or Rear Wheel Drive.
 Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.
- 6. Suspension: Stabilizer Bars are not necessary for vehicles with today's built-in stability control. Stability control is already listed with the Brake requirements. Recommendation: (1) Change stabilizer bars to "factory engineered stability control". Add the requirement for Dual Rear Wheel for additional stability and interior space.

Response: Stabilizer bar(s) are required, specification remains the same.

7. Ground Clearance: Note: 12 inches of ground clearance is not compatible for a standard full-size cargo/DUI Van

Recommendation: Change to Minimum Ground Clearance 6 inches

Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.

8. Steering: Rack & Pinion Electronic Power Steering: This is outdated and unnecessary. Recommendation: Vehicle shall be equipped with the latest factory engineered and FMVSS approved steering system and components.

Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.

9. Delivery Time: 120 Days

Please amend to allow 180 days for a DUI Van conversion upfit build, ship and delivery.

Response: Please refer to Amendment #2.
