Questions and Concerns received from Pacific Unlimited, Inc. on June 26, 2025.

1. Bidder shall have at least a minimum of current ASE Certification mechanics on hand to verify work completed by their staff. What is the minimum?
Response: The minimum number of required ASE-certified mechanics on hand to verify work completed should be 2 (two). Refer to amendment #1
2. Is ASE Transit Bus Certified technicians required?
Response: ASE Transit Bus Certified (H Series) Mechanics are recommended or preferred, but are not mandatory. ASE Certified Mechanics or other ASE certifications are acceptable.
3. When requested, GRTA requires within 3 working days to diagnose, provide necessary labor, materials, and parts, except when provided by GRTA, a Maintenance Repair Facility including apparatuses, lifts and safety equipment necessary to complete repairs. What is GRTA's expectation for special order parts?
Response: Special order parts are items that a business does not typically keep in stock and are ordered specifically at a customer's request. All special order parts will be ordered and shipped via express delivery services, determined by the cost, size, and weight, with GRTA's written consent.
4. Is GRTA considering paying for bench stock items?
Response: No, refer to amendment #1.
