# Eight of 518 Test Positive for COVID-19; UPDATED: COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Schedule; Food Commodities Distribution Continues

### **Results: Eight New Cases of COVID-19**

**Eight (8)** new cases of COVID-19 were identified out of **518** tests performed on July 26. To date, there have been a total of **8,514** officially reported cases of COVID-19 with **143** deaths, **52** cases in active isolation, and **8,319** not in active isolation. **The CAR Score is 0.3.** 

*Operation Liberate Guam update:* To date, a total of **95,427** or **79.5%** of adults have received either both doses in the two-dose series (Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna) or the single-dose series (Johnson & Johnson/Janssen) of the COVID-19 vaccine.

#### **COVID-19 Vaccination Schedule**

COVID-19 vaccination clinics continue at the locations and times below. Bring a photo ID. Those due for their second dose are reminded to bring their COVID-19 immunization card. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and provide government-issued identification to validate age. Minor's birth certificate is acceptable. Parent/legal guardian must have a government-issued ID. Guardians must also present legal guardianship or power-of-attorney document.

COVID-19 community testing continues. No symptoms are needed to qualify for testing. Bring a photo ID. Results available onsite. Testing for travel purposes will **not** be conducted at these community testing sites. Call the DPHSS Northern Region Community Health Center at 635-7525/6 to schedule an appointment for COVID-19 testing for travel. Priority is given to patients under investigation and those traveling for medical purposes. Only four (4) people per vehicle are allowed to be tested.
