32 Hospitalized for COVID-19 – 22 Unvaccinated

COVID-19 Test Results: 147 of 1,456 Test Positive for COVID-19

Today, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) reported **147** new cases of COVID-19 out of **1,456** tests performed on August 24. Seventy-four (74) cases were identified through contact tracing. One (1) case reported recent travel history and was identified in quarantine. To date, there have been a total of **9,759** officially reported cases of COVID-19 with **145** deaths, **939** cases in active isolation and **8,675** not in active isolation. The CAR Score is **23.4**.

Guam COVID-19 Vaccination Update

As of August 24, 690 additional residents received their first dose in a two-dose series, 196 residents received their dose in the single-dose series and an additional 329 residents have become fully vaccinated. To date, a total of 107,838 (79.12%) of Guam's eligible population (residents 12 years and older) is fully vaccinated. This percentage includes 8,735 fully vaccinated residents between the ages of 12 - 17, as well as Guam's fully vaccinated adult population of 99,103.

Fifteen GDOE Students Test Positive for COVID-19

Today, the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) confirmed fifteen positive cases for COVID-19 involving students. The cases were identified at Adacao Elementary School, Astumbo Elementary School, C.L. Taitano Elementary, Inarajan Elementary School, Liguan Elementary School, Merizo Martyrs Memorial Elementary School, Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary School, Pedro C. Lujan Elementary School, Agueda I. Johnston Middle School, F.B. Leon Guerrero Middle School, Jose Rios Middle School, and Simon Sanchez High School. In collaboration with the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), GDOE has identified and notified teachers as well as parents of students who may have been in contact with the index case in order to schedule testing. Tested individuals will remain in quarantine until they are cleared by DPHSS to return to campus. Cleaning and disinfecting of areas of the campuses are taking place to ensure schools are ready for regular hours of operation on Thursday, August 26.

UPDATE: COVID-19 Testing Continues Through Saturday, August 28

Free COVID-19 testing continues at the old carnival grounds in Tiyan, Barrigada from 8 a.m. to 12 noon. Daily testing will run through Saturday, August 28, 2021. Only polymerase chain reaction (PCR) testing will be performed. Up to 400 tests will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Samples will be collected through nasopharyngeal swabs. No symptoms are needed. Bring a photo ID.

COVID-19 test results can be expected within 24 hours. To receive results via email, send a request to <u>covidresults@dphss.guam.gov</u>. For quicker service, visit

<u>dphss.guam.gov/covid-19-testing</u> to download, print, and complete a <u>COVID-19 Testing Patient</u> <u>Assessment Form</u> before arriving at the testing site.

Only four (4) people per vehicle are allowed to be tested. Minors must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian and provide government-issued identification to validate age. The

parent/legal guardian will also be required to sign a consent form. Testing for travel purposes will **not** be conducted at DPHSS drive-thru testing sites and must be scheduled with the Northern Region Community Health Center (NRCHC) by calling (671) 635-7525/6.

The community is reminded to monitor for symptoms and get tested if they are identified as close contacts to confirmed positive cases or are experiencing any of the known COVID-19 symptoms, which include, but are not limited to:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath

- Muscle pain
- Sore throat

• Fever

• New loss of taste or smell

Chills

This list is not exhaustive of all possible symptoms. Other less common symptoms have been reported, including gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Food Commodities Distribution Continues

GDOE, State Agency for the Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) under the U.S. Department of Agriculture Food Nutrition Service distribution will be available to village constituents only on a first-come, first-served basis. Distribution is limited to three households per vehicle at the sites. Face masks must be worn; bring a photo ID.

Any remaining bags from the drive-thru distribution will be delivered door-to-door beginning on August 27. Those who did not receive a bag for various reasons (i.e. no transportation, elderly persons, etc.) will be prioritized.
