71 Hospitalized for COVID-19 – 39 Unvaccinated

Preliminary COVID-19 Test Results: 67 New Cases

Today, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) reported a preliminary case count of **sixty-seven (67)** new cases of COVID-19 from **642** specimens analyzed on September 10. Additional results are pending analysis and submission from other clinics and will be reported on Monday, September 13. To date, there have been a total of **12,294** officially reported cases of COVID-19 with **159** deaths, **2,691** cases in active isolation, and **9,445** not in active isolation. As of September 10, **the CAR Score is 39.2.**

For quicker service, visit <u>dphss.guam.gov/covid-19-testing</u> to download, print, and complete a <u>COVID-19 Testing Patient Assessment Form</u> before arriving at the testing site. Only four (4) people per vehicle are allowed to be tested. Minors must be accompanied by a parent/legal

guardian and provide government-issued identification to validate age. The parent/legal guardian will also be required to sign a consent form. Testing for travel purposes will **not** be conducted at DPHSS drive-thru testing sites and must be scheduled with the Northern Region Community Health Center (NRCHC) by calling (671) 635-7525/6.

The community is reminded to monitor for symptoms and get tested if they are identified as close contacts to confirmed positive cases or are experiencing any of the known COVID-19 symptoms, which include, but are not limited to:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Fever
- Chills

- Muscle pain
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

This list is not exhaustive of all possible symptoms. Other less common symptoms have been reported, including gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Individuals waiting for COVID-19 test results must quarantine at home until cleared by DPHSS. Individuals whose test results are positive and who are at high risk for serious illness will be given information on outpatient monoclonal antibody treatment for COVID-19.

Three GDOE Employees Test Positive for COVID-19

Today, the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) confirmed positive cases for COVID-19 involving **three (3)** employees. The employee cases were identified at J.Q San Miguel

Elementary School, Lyndon B. Johnson Elementary School, and Agueda I. Johnston Middle School. In collaboration with the DPHSS, GDOE has identified and notified teachers as well as parents of students who may have been in contact with the index case in order to schedule testing. Tested individuals will remain in quarantine until they are cleared by DPHSS. Cleaning and disinfecting of areas of the campuses are taking place.

Guam COVID-19 Vaccination Update

As of September 10, 160 additional residents received their first dose in a two-dose series, 18 residents received their dose in the single-dose series, and an additional 222 residents have become fully vaccinated. To date, a total of 112,196 (82.32%) of Guam's eligible population (residents 12 years and older) is fully vaccinated. This percentage includes 9,314 fully vaccinated residents between the ages of 12 - 17, as well as Guam's fully vaccinated adult population of 102,882.
